- Prior to the fall of Jerusalem in Jeremiah's time, the Ark drops out of sight posing the question: Where is it today?

## 1 SPECULATIONS & SUGGESTIONS Concerning The Ark

- Some Muslims teachers claim the Ark to be in Mecca, Saudi Arabia.
- The apocryphal book of [2 Maccabees 2:4 8] says Jeremiah hid it close to where Moses is buried on mount Nebo.
- 7th Day Adventist, Ron Wyatt suggests it is buried directly below where the cross of Jesus was situated.
- Some suggest it is buried in an elaborate network of tunnels and chambers under the temple mount in Jerusalem.
- Another theory is that it is in Ethiopia. (The St Mary of Zion church in Aksum).

## 2 We Are The Temple Of God

- Consider [1 Corinthians 3:16 17], [2 Corinthians 6:16].
- Collectively the people of God are the temple of God and God dwells in us. [Ezekiel 48:35].

## 3 The Ark In The Future

- The 1st temple (Solomon's) was destroyed by the Babylonians in 6th century BC.
- The 2nd temple rebuilt by Zerubbabel was destroyed by the Romans in AD70.
- On the temple site today resides the Muslim Al Aqsa mosque and the Dome
  of the Rock shrine.
- When Christ returns to set up His Kingdom a 3rd temple will be built. [Ezekiel's vision].
- Not for 'anti-christ' to sit in as dispensational futurists suggest but for Christ to reign from.
- [Ezekiel 43:7] speaks of this temple being 'the place of My throne.'
- The place for the Ark to be situated and where God will dwell in the midst of His people.
