- 1 Timothy has 6 chapters and 113 verses.
- Ten of Paul's letters were to churches but 4 were to individuals.

1 Who Was Timothy?

- See [Acts 16] and [2 Timothy 1:5/3:15]
- He lived at Lystra with his mother, Eunice and grandmother Lois.
- He was 'well spoken of by the brethren'.
- Eunice raised a Christian, an apostle and a champion for the church.
- · Paul recruits Timothy as an assistant but a great friendship grew.
- It was like a father/son relationship.
- · Paul writes his last letter to Timothy.

2 The Occasion Of The Letter

- Paul sent Timothy to 'pastor' the church at Ephesus.
- He had prophesied in [Acts 20:29-31] that false teachers would arise in that church.
- Timothy is despatched to counter the false teaching/teachers.
- This letter was to encourage Timothy in his task.

- · Ch. 4 The leader's relationship to doctrine/teaching
- Ch. 5 The leader's relationship to the church people
- Ch. 6 The leaders relationship to false teachers and money.

4 The Importance Of Doctrine

- The word 'doctrine(s)' used 9 times in 1 Timothy.
- If doctrine is not important then Paul wasted his time for the bulk of his letters is 'doctrine.'
- Doctrine enables us to talk about Jesus.
- If we don't know true doctrine how will we identify false doctrine when it comes along?

5 Godly Leadership

- God's policy has always been leadership in the church. [1 Corinthians 12:28]
- 'Governments/administrations' come from the Greek word 'kubernesis'.
- The word for a ship's pilot guiding a ship through a narrow channel.
- Chapter 3 is the qualities of a leader in the church.
- Leadership in the church is 'servant leadership'. [Matthew 20:25-28].

6 The Danger Of Riches

- (See 6:6-16 & 17-19).
- Money must be kept as a servant. Never allowed to become a god.
- Many have been seduced away from the 'King's Highway' by riches.
- Money is a gift from God to be accounted for like all God's gifts to us.
- Adopt and live by the '10-80-10' principle.
