Introduction

- Daniel has been shown a panoramic preview of the future.
- A disturbing '*revelation*' of the kingdoms of men in opposition to the kingdom of God.
- But in the end 'the saints' get to live happily ever after.

1 The Ancient Of Days

- Many names/titles for God in book of Daniel.
- In Daniel alone, He is referred to as 'the Ancient of days.'
- [Vs 9]. The title is a designation for God on His throne ruling and dispensing His judgement.
- Seated as absolute monarch and Judge of all the earth.
- NB. The fire. [Hebrews 12:29].
- The 'Ancient of days' has neither birth or death certificates.
- In His time, He actions the demise of one kingdom and the rise of another.

2 The Son Of Man [Vs 13]

- This title is used of Jesus in gospels 81 times.
- The 'Son of Man' is the 'Godman' tabernacling in flesh.
- "Coming with clouds" is the standard expression describing His Second Coming. [Matthew 24:30].
- [Vs 14] The Ancient of Days gives the 'Son of Man' an everlasting Kingdom and dominion.
- This is the kingdom symbolised by the stone striking the image in [Daniel 2].
- That stone kingdom fills the whole earth. [Revelation 11:15].
- The throne promised in [Luke 1:32/33] will also be given to the 'Son of Man'

3 The Saints Of The Most High

- These saints are the Blood washed and Blood bought people of God in every age. [Acts 26:10], [Ephesians 1:1].
- 'Saints' from Greek word 'hagios' meaning 'holy/sanctified ones.'
- Despite anti God kingdoms the saints will finally triumph and inherit an everlasting kingdom.
