PART 11: CURIOUS GOINGS ON IN AN UPPER ROOM

Reading: Acts 2:1 - 4

Introduction

- In the Old Testament the coming of the Holy Spirit **UPON** a person was a very rare thing.
- [Joel 2:28/29] foretells a time when it can be the experience of **ALL** God's people.
- They could have their own personal '*anointing*'

1 It Was PROPHESED By The Prophets

- See [Joel 2:28/29], [Isaiah 28:11] and [Matthew 3:11].

2 It Was PREDICTED By The Lord Jesus

- See [Luke 24:49], [Mark 16:17 - 18] and [Acts 1:8].

3 It Was PERFORMED On The Believers At Pentecost

- The time had come for prophecy to be fulfilled.
- **“When the day of Pentecost had fully come.”** (50 days after the Sabbath of Passover week).
- It was A Sunday.
- **“They.”** The 120 men and women.
- **“Were all in one accord in one place.”** They knew why they were there.
- **“And suddenly.”** The time came for the promises to come good.
- **“There came a sound from heaven as of a mighty rushing wind.”** (They heard it & felt it).
- **“Then there appeared to them divided tongues as of fire...”** Fire is often associated with God. (They saw it).
- **“And they were ALL filled with the Holy Spirit.”** None left out. (They felt it).
- **“They began to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.”**
- They experienced the *‘glossolalia’* from *‘glossa’* the Greek word for *‘tongue.’*

4 Note Carefully

- The Holy Spirit did not do the speaking. They did.
- It was the languages of surrounding nations.
- They didn’t learn these languages.
- They were given to them miraculously.
- [1 Corinthians 13:1] There is also the languages of angels.
- Pentecost is not a church, its an experience.

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
